Leaflet on AStA Sports Promotion

What is funded by AStA?

The AStA promotes the participation and organisation of sporting events, championships and tournaments in which the student body or Trier University are represented, in particular <u>German University Sports Federation (ADH)</u> events.

Am I eligible for funding?

If you are enrolled at the University of Trier and represent the university yourself or through a student sports group at an ADH sports event or other tournaments, yes.

Which costs are covered?

The AStA covers registration fees (€35/person; €150/group), travel and catering costs in accordance with our <u>travel expenses regulation</u> as well as any other expenses for organisation and materials.

How do I submit an application?

Submit an application to the AK Sport via our <u>application form</u> <u>as far in advance of the planned event</u> <u>as possible</u>. This should contain the following information:

- Name of the applicant / sports group (with contact person)
- Type, scope and form of the events
- Number of eligible participants (students of Trier University)
- List of costs: registration fees, travel and catering costs, and other costs
 - Justification for travel costs incurred & choice of means of transport

Your application will be voted on by the AStA or StuPa (from €1000). If it is accepted, you will receive further information about the proof of use.

How do I get my money, then?

Before we transfer the money, we need a few documents as proof of participation:

- Invoices and receipts for all costs incurred
- Copies of the student ID cards of all participants who are to be sponsored

In addition to the direct evidence, we also require a <u>short report</u> on the participation, which may also be published on the AStA channels after consultation.

What else is there to consider?
